






MISSION To improve lives by providing essential home furnishings to those seeking housing stability.





HOW WE SERVE

As THE furniture bank of Kansas City, Flourish provides free whole-home furnishings to those who have lost their homes due to displacement, poverty, or trauma. In 2021, we furnished **760** homes, impacting the lives of **1,853** people, including 907 children. 85% of our clients were previously unhoused, and 87% had incomes at or below the poverty level. We partnered with **69** social service agencies ranging from domestic violence shelters to refugee resettlement agencies. **317** volunteers contributed **17,141** hours to collect, repair, and distribute furnishings to our clients. Thanks to their hard work, we distributed **30,475** donated items, diverting **208** tons of furniture waste from the landfill.




VOLUNTEERS


Flourish is led by a passionate and dedicated community of volunteers. In 2021, 317 volunteers contributed 17,141 hours of labor, equivalent to an estimated value of \$489,000. Thanks to our volunteers' hard work collecting, repairing, and refurbishing donations, we distributed 30,475 items - saving 208 tons of unwanted furniture from the landfill.

FINANCIALS

Flourish operated with a budget of \$369,603 funding our warehouse, moving trucks, two full-time staff, and additional items for clients. Our inventory of whole-home furnishings was maintained through generous donations from businesses, clubs, and individuals.
